Engineering & Operations Policy No. 315

Subject: Mobile Home Line Extensions

Dated: May 11, 2006

Revised: February 11, 2010

Replaces: Board Policy No. 407 dated May 10, 1997

I. OBJECTIVE

To establish and state the Cooperative's policy for providing electric service to mobile homes in the service area of West Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation.

II. POLICY

1. Distribution overhead line extensions to mobile homes.

A. First 150 feet:

- Extensions of up to 150 feet from the nearest facility or public road shall be made without charge.

B. Over 150 feet and less than or equal to 300 feet:

- Extensions greater than 150 feet and less than or equal to 300 feet from the nearest facility or public road shall be made provided that the customer pays a "customer advance for construction" of fifty (\$50.00) dollars. This advance shall be refunded to the paying customer one (1) year after the service connection date provided that the mobile home has continually received service.

C. Over 300 feet and less than or equal to 800 feet:

- Extensions greater than 300 feet and less than or equal to 800 feet from the nearest facility or public road shall be made provided that the customer pays, in addition to the \$50 as specified in B. above, a cost of \$2.25 per foot plus right-of-way costs for that portion of the line. This advance shall be refunded to the paying customer over a four (4) year period in equal amounts provided that the mobile home has continually received service.

D. Over 800 feet:

- Extensions over 800 feet from the nearest facility or public road shall be made provided the customer pays, in addition to the fees associated with B. & C. above, a cost of \$4.50 per foot plus right-of-way costs for that portion of the line.
- Any consumer who is charged a fee for extensions over 800 feet, shall be reimbursed part or all of said fee for a period of up to five (5) years from the date the service is connected for any new consumers receiving service to a permanent residence from the portion of line for which said fee was charged. It is the responsibility of the consumer who paid the fee to notify the cooperative of any new connections. The amount reimbursed shall be determined as follows:

- a. In the event the permanent residential connection is made directly to the portion of line for which the fee was charged, then the consumer who paid the fee shall receive up to \$3,600.00 in reimbursement.
- b. In the event a new extension is made from any portion of the line for which the consumer paid the fee, then the consumer shall be reimbursed \$4.50 per foot for the difference between 800 feet and the actual length of the extension.
- In no event shall the reimbursement exceed the amount of the fee. No reimbursement shall be made for additional consumers connected after the five year period as mentioned above.
- In the event the service to the mobile home is disconnected and/or removed and another mobile home or permanent dwelling does not take its place, no refunds shall be made for additional customers connected after this time.

2. Distribution underground line extensions to mobile homes.

- A. Underground extensions will be installed at the following cost:

Trenching and piping - \$3.00 per foot (\$350 minimum)

Wire installation - All fees incurred in 1. above plus \$3.00 per foot

III. RESPONSIBILITY


It shall be the responsibility of the President & CEO to assure compliance with this policy.
